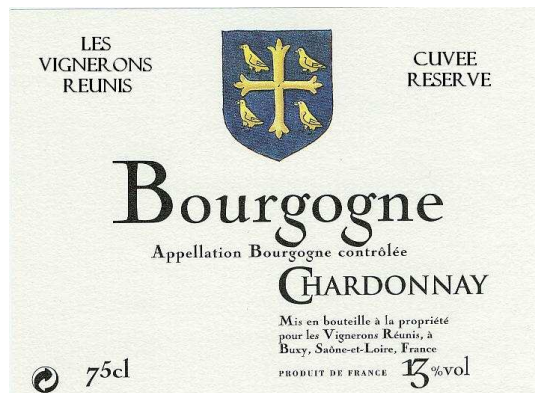


BURGUNDY

A small growers' cooperative in Buxy on the Côte Chalonnaise of southern Burgundy has turned out to be a pleasant surprise, the reward for a long day spent knocking about in the Chalonnaise. Indeed, this group of thirty small growers can turn out wines that compete with many of the more renowned names in Burgundy with their exemplary Côte Chalonnaise offerings. Most notable among these wines is their superlative Bourgogne Blanc “Cuvée Réserve,” which comes from Chardonnay vineyards surrounding the tiny village of Buxy, part of the Montagny appellation.

One finds in good Bourgogne Blanc a wine full of country charm, purity and subtlety of flavor. The “Cuvée Réserve” Bourgogne Chardonnay is our selection from the cellars of the Vignerons Réunis de Buxy. Pleasing to the eye, with the radiance of pure sunshine, this Bourgogne Blanc starts off right and doesn't miss a step. It willingly offers from the glass a pretty fragrance of acacia flower, lemon oil, summer apples, and pure, unfettered Chardonnay fruit. Moreover, all of this Bourgogne Blanc's aromatic profile follows through on the palate, leaving the mouth clean and refreshed, and most assuredly eager for more. This is a wine with plenty of flavor and eminent drinkability. The “Cuvée Réserve” is our exclusive selection from the Vignerons Réunis de Buxy.
