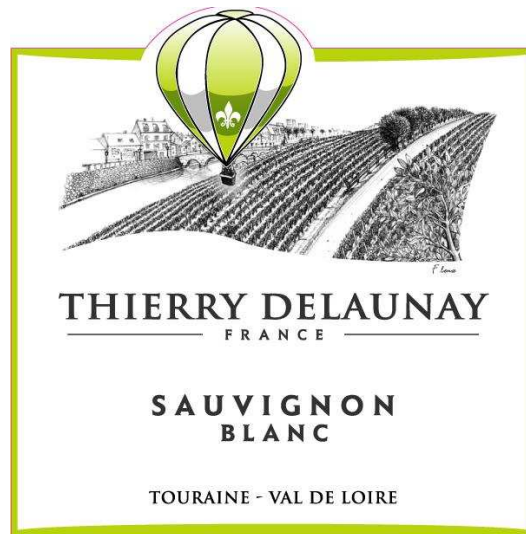


TOURAINE

DOMAINE THIERRY DELAUNAY



Domaine Thierry Delaunay comprises 21 hectares of vineyards situated on the banks of the Cher, 50 kilometres east of Tours, in the appellation contrôlée region of Touraine. These vineyards, have been cultivated by 5 generations of the same family, passing from father to son, and extend all around the winery. The family works only with the traditional grapes of the region: Sauvignon Blanc, Gamay and Cabernet Franc, as well as two exciting but lesser known varietals, Côt and Pineau d'Aunis.

The diversity of different soils in the Domaine explains the number of different red and white grape varieties : the clay and flint soils or « perruches » give the red wines distinctive qualities which are typical of the « terroir », while the white and rosé wines derive their elegance and finesse from the finer, less stony soils.

The first wines were bottled at the Domaine in 1971. Each year since then, the Delaunay family has striven to improve the quality of the wines by combining the best of traditional procedures with the latest technology. As a result their wines have gained gradually in reputation both in France and abroad. Today all the wines are produced and bottled at the Domaine

The wines have been consistently acknowledged in international competitions, having been awarded Gold Medals for 3 consecutive years at the Concours Général Agricole de Paris and for 2 consecutive years at the Concours National des Caves Particulières and Concours Mondial des Vins de Bruxelles.
