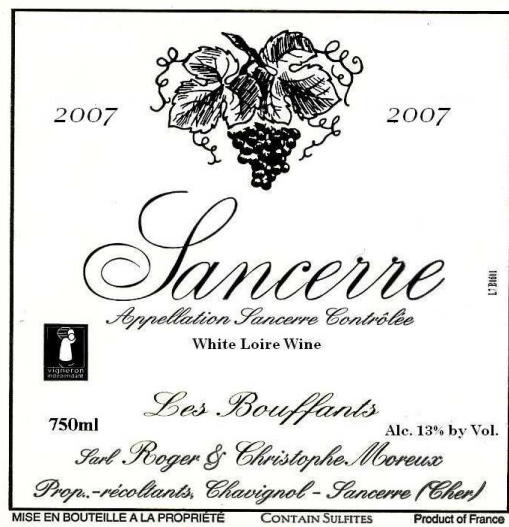


SANCERRE

DOMAINE ROGER & CHRISTOPHE MOREUX



CÉPAGE: 100% Sauvignon Blanc

The estate of Domaine Roger & Christophe Moreux represents the best in artisanal wine making. It has been well-established in Sancerre since 1895, and the work of the vineyards has been handed down from father to son for many generations. Each vineyard site of the domaine is vinified separately to fully express the terroir.

Moreux's "Les Bouffants" comes from a parcel of limestone soil covered with rocks, or "caillottes." This extremely steep, stony vineyard yields an aromatic wine of great minerality that is not only richly-aromatic, but crisp and racy. It is located beside Les Monts Damnés, the "Grand Cru" site of Chavignol. Located just a few short minutes from the village of Sancerre, Chavignol wines are known for their steely, racy character. Chavignol is also home to France's greatest goat cheeses.

Manual harvest and long lees contact contribute to the extraordinary combination of persistent bouquet, concentration and finesse of Moreux's wines. The Moreux wines traditionally exhibit an abundance of flavors and complexities: intense aromas of wild flowers, fresh figs and melon, a firm structure rich in glycerin, and a long, refreshing finish. These wines are exceedingly pleasurable whether served as an aperitif, with oysters and shellfish, a goat cheese salad or with fish in a delicate sauce. Unlike the vast majority of simple Sancerres, Moreux's wines age extremely well for many years.

M. Moreux also produces an excellent Sancerre Rouge. Highly aromatic, with an earthy bouquet of strawberries and cherries, it is an elegant expression of Pinot Noir.
