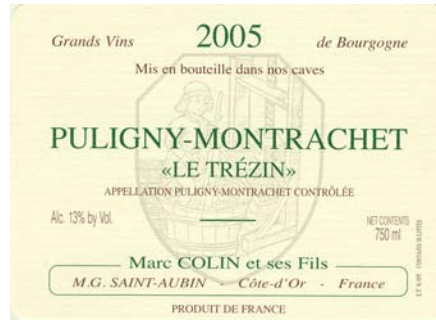


CHASSAGNE-MONTRACHET DOMAINE MARC COLIN



2007 Marc Colin Chassagne Montrachet “Les Caillerets” “Sweet Spot Outstanding” **92 Points**

“A pure, elegant and airy nose offers up notes of white flower, lemon zest, wet stone and an herbal hint that transfers over to the equally stony and beautifully detailed middle weight flavors that possess real verve and punch on the textured and firm finish. This does a slow build from the mid-palate to the palate staining finish. A Zen wine of understatement but real character.” **Burghound 7/1/2009**

2007 Marc Colin Chassagne Montrachet "Encégnières"

“Outstanding Top Value” **90 Points**

“This is bigger than its Puligny counterpart but trades size for elegance. The resin and floral aromas evidence traces of earth and herb, both of which are reflected by the bigger and richer medium plus weight flavors that possess good power and punch on the lingering and sappy finish. 2007 Marc Colin St. Aubin “En Remilly”

“Outstanding Top Value” **89 Points**

“The most elegant nose to this point with its lemon zest, orange peel and acacia blossom aromas that seamlessly merge into rich but detailed flavors that are intensely mineral suffused, all wrapped in a sophisticated, pure and lemony finish. This is worth considering.” **Burghound 7/1/2009**

2007 Marc Colin Puligny Montrachet "Le Trézin"

“Outstanding” **89 Points**

“A cool, airy and fresh nose with green apple and citrus notes leads to nicely mineral-infused medium-bodied flavors that possess good detail, punch and vibrancy on the agreeably dry finish. This is really quite good and very Puligny in character and is sufficiently forward that it could be drunk now with pleasure or cellared for 1 to 3 years first.
