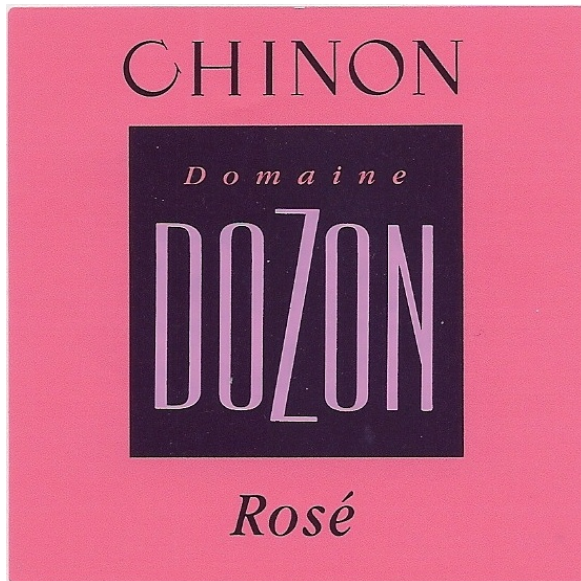


DOMAINE DOZON

CHINON ROSÉ



Domaine Dozon is located south of Chinon, on the left bank of the Vienne. Originally a traditional livestock and produce farm, they turned to viticulture with the acquisition of 5 ha within the renowned Clos du Saut au Loup in the early 20th century. Eric Santier, a Chinon native, purchased the Domaine in 2013 from Laure Dozon, with help from the esteemed Baudry family, for whom he had worked. Some of the older, less desirable barrels were discarded, replaced with fiberglass tanks and Santier now seeks to make more pure and fresh expressions of wine from his village. This is clean, mindful yet traditional winemaking at its best.

Vinification and Elevage: The rosé is made from younger vines planted throughout the entirety of the domaine. The skins are left in contact with the juice for a brief time, then directly pressed. Fermentation and aging takes place in fiberglass tanks.

Tasting Notes: Vibrant pink color, with delicate notes of strawberries, apricots and cherry coming with hints of bell pepper and herbs.

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
