
## Domaine Jean-Marie Bouzereau Puligny-Montrachet 1<sup>er</sup> Cru « Les Folatières »



The Bouzereau family is based in Meursault where they have been growing grapes for over 10 generations, and with two vigneron grandfathers, one in Meursault and one in Volnay, Jean-Marie Bouzereau has a rich family heritage of the vine and wine. After studying at CF-PPA Beaune, Jean-Marie interned at wineries both in the United States and in Australia before returning to the family estate in Meursault in 1994. He now farms 9 hectares predominantly in the village of Meursault with smaller parcels in Puligny-Montrachet, Volnay, Beaune and Pommard. Jean-Marie's style is a per-

fect marriage of restrained ripeness combined with traditional winemaking that result in exceptional examples of the appellation.

**Vinification and Elevage:** Grapes are pressed and allowed to gently settle for 24 hours. Fermentation is done with all natural yeasts, in barrel as well as malolactic fermentation. Aging is typically 1 year in wood, on the lees utilizing 20-30% new oak.

**About the Vineyard:** "Les Folatières, or Ez Folatières 1er Cru" is a 17.64 ha vineyard located in the center of the slope, directly under Champ Gain. The limestone is particularly impressive here and the thin top soils, along with heavy erosion patterns makes Folatières a great vineyard site.

**Tasting Notes:** Floral elegance coupled with butter, apples and cream. good weight and length. A beautiful rendition.
